Interested in using cannabis for back or spine pain?

The doctors at the University of Colorado Department of Orthopedics are conducting a research study to learn more about the use of oral cannabis for back or neck pain.

Inclusion Criteria:

To participate you must be in good overall health, be between 21-84 years old, and have chronic back or neck pain. You must also be willing to not use personal cannabis products while participating in the study.



Participation:

If you meet all study criteria, you will complete three separate treatments of 5 weeks each for a total of 22 weeks. Each treatment phase contains different study drug: oral cannabis with THC, oral cannabis with CBD and THC, and placebo.



The total time to complete the study will be about 6 months. Compensation up to \$465 is provided.
