



Volunteers Needed for a Research Study on Sex Hormone and Blood Vessel Function at the Division of Renal Diseases and Hypertension Clinical Research Unit

Study Purpose: This research study will compare sex hormone concentrations in healthy women to women with chronic kidney disease. We also measure blood vessel function using non-invasive testing.

We are looking for:

- ❖ Women
- ❖ Aged 18-44 OR 55-75 years
- ❖ Generally healthy and free from hypertension
OR
Have Chronic kidney disease (CKD)
- ❖ Non-smokers
- ❖ Free from advanced CKD requiring chronic dialysis
- ❖ Women must not take an oral contraceptive or not use oral hormone replacement therapy
- ❖ Women must not be pregnant or trying to become pregnant

As a volunteer, you will receive the following information about your health:

- ✓ Resting EKG
- ✓ Blood Cholesterol Screening
- ✓ Blood Sugar Screening
- ✓ Blood Pressure Screening
- ✓ Physical Exam



Participants will receive \$50 for study testing visit.

Participation will consist of one screening visit (approximately an hour) and one testing visit (approximately 3 hours of time or less). The testing visit will include non-invasive testing of blood vessel function. Testing takes place at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus.
