If you are 18 years or older and you are initiating treatment for Opioid Use...

You may be eligible to participate in a research study.

Office-based Methadone Versus Buprenorphine to Address Retention in Medication for Opioid Use Treatment

The research study is comparing methadone and buprenorphine for treatment for opioid use.

All medication is prescribed by a clinician and picked up at the Kaiser Permanente Colorado pharmacy.

You must be willing to be randomly assigned to receive either methadone or buprenorphine from your doctor.

What is involved:

- One in-person visit for screening
- Six monthly visits
- Weekly remote questionnaire
- Total time = 6 months

You will be compensated for your time.
