

Identifying Brain Cancer Targeted Self-Management Intervention Content and Delivery Adaptations

Purpose of the Research Study

The purpose of this research study is to assess the best ways to adapt existing interventions for other chronic diseases (i.e., epilepsy, stroke, diabetes) to meet the needs of brain cancer survivors.

Inclusion Criteria

- Adults aged 18 or over
- Currently living in the United States with confirmed malignant brain tumor (diffuse glioma, World Health Organization (WHO) grades II, III, and IV)
- Who are at least one month past initial diagnosis and one month past any surgical resections.



Duration of Participation

- Survey duration: ~20-30 minutes
- Focus group duration: ~90 minutes
