- it will be helpful if you have an allergy blood tests in the past and if you have those results

Main Procedures Involved:

- If you join the study, you will be asked about your medical history, specifically about your prior allergic conditions and details of your symptoms.
- About 3-4 tablespoons of blood will be drawn to be used for research.
